


LBUSD Preliminary Administrative Services Credential Program

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

LBUSD is launching its own PASC program for credentialed district employees starting in May 2024. Approved by the California Teacher Credentialing Commission, LBUSD’s PASC is designed to support innovative, equity-centered school and central office leaders ready to re-imagine learning in support of Vision 2035. Faculty: Current LBUSD Principals and Central Office Leaders

Cost: \$2,500

Coursework: May, 2024-June 2025 (three semesters)

Format: Hybrid (in-person one evening per week and online)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Current employee in Long Beach Unified School District (LBUSD)
- Have a valid California credential
- Minimum of four years of successful full-time experience in the fields of teaching, pupil personnel, school nurse, teacher librarian, speech-language pathology, or clinical or rehabilitative services
- Fulfilled Basic Skills Requirement (i.e. CBEST, coursework required for base credential)
- Two letters of recommendation (one must be from current principal/supervisor)
- Current Resume
- Statement of Leadership Philosophy
- Commitment to employment in the LBUSD for a minimum of five years upon completion of the PASC Program
